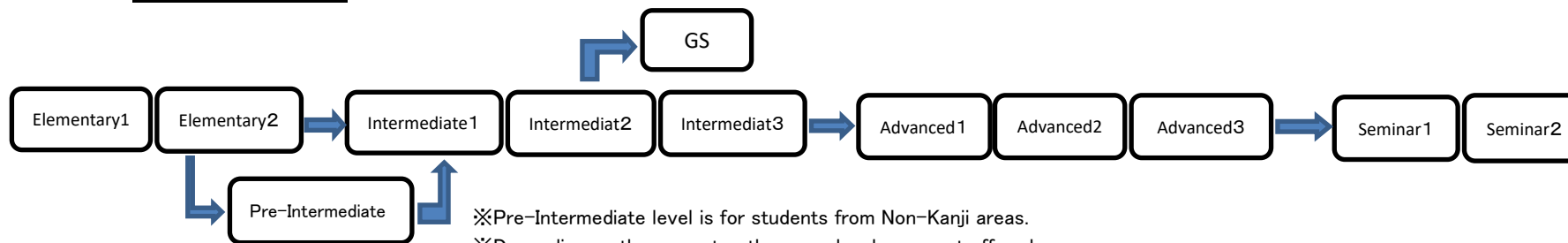


Level overview

※Students are placed in the same class for 1 term (about for 3 months). Promotion is judged based on the score of term exam and how they study in class.
